

Request for Second Review (appeal)

Second appeals are conducted by the University Appellate Board, a branch of the Office of Student Conduct. The Appellate Board considers appeals that include **new** and **relevant** information not provided with the original review request, such as supporting documents, receipts, letters of support, and so on.

Second appeals are an appeal of the original decision, not the validity of the citation. The burden of proof is on the appellant to demonstrate that the original review decision should be overturned.
